

CENTRAL LAKES COMMUNITY COLLEGE

The College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU) welcome Central Lakes Community College transfer students. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Core Curriculum requirements they will fulfill.

Transferable courses are defined as *courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 1000 or above*. Note: A minimum of three semester credits is required to complete a CSB/SJU core curriculum requirement, with the exception of fine arts.

At least 45 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

Finally, it should be noted that this guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. Listed below each of the CSB/SJU Core Curriculum requirements (bolded) are the **Central Lakes Community College** courses that fulfill that specific requirement.

FIRST YEAR SYMPOSIUM

Transfer credits need to be discussed with Academic Advising.

HUMANITIES

A course from two different disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits.

ENGL: 1463, 1466, 1467, 1468, 1469, 2451, 2455, 2457, 2458, 2467, 2468

HIST: 1401, 1402, 1411, 1470, 1471

HUMT: 1401, 1430

PHIL: All courses

MATH (one course)

MATH: 1441, 1457, 1460, 1477, 1478, 2457, 2458, 2459

(1467, 1468 will fulfill proficiency requirement but not the math course requirement)

NATURAL SCIENCES

A course from two different science disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits—all courses must have labs.

BIOL: All courses except 2411 (2401 and 2402 must be taken together, 2416 and 2417 must be taken together)

CHEM: All courses except 1405 and 2457

ESCI: 1411, 1441, 1456

PHYS: All courses except 1406

SOCIAL SCIENCES

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement.

ANTH: 1457

ECON: 1450, 2401, 2402

GEOG: 2401

POLS: 1430, 1435, 1439, 2450

PSYC: 2421, 2422, 2431, 2441

SOCL: 1401, 1471, 2411, 2422, 2481

FINE ARTS

A minimum of four semester credits is necessary to fulfill the requirement.

ART: All courses except 2583

HUMT: 1461

MUSC: All courses

THTR: All courses except 2491

FOREIGN LANGUAGES

A student will have fulfilled the foreign language requirement if he/she has documented proficiency through the intermediate level or has taken courses through Intermediate 2401.

ADDITIONAL COURSES ACCEPTED FOR ELECTIVE CREDIT

These courses may or may not fulfill major requirements. Major departments will determine what requirements may be fulfilled by transfer work.
